Respiratory Care Assistant / Cardio-Pulmonary Services / PRN (as needed) Rotating 7:00 AM – 7:00 PM and 3:00 PM – 11:00 PM. Must have completed one year of their Respiratory curriculum. Must be enrolled with NCRCB within 60 days of employment. Must have a provisional license before working with patients. Enrolled in approved 2-year technical program for respiratory therapy. BCLS certification. Provides respiratory care to patients through administration of therapeutic gases and drugs, and by setting up and monitoring respirators and other devices. Patient population includes neo-nates, infants, pediatrics, adolescents, adults, and geriatrics. \$11.72 minimum.

Occupational Therapist / Occupational Therapy / Part-time / 20-24 hours per week, 1st shift. Baccalaureate Degree in Occupational Therapy from AOTA recognized program. Current NC license. CPR certification for health care providers required. Evaluates patients referred for occupational therapy to maximize ability to resume daily living and vocational activities. Develops, communicates, coordinates, implements, monitors and revises treatment plan with goal of maximizing patient’s capabilities.
